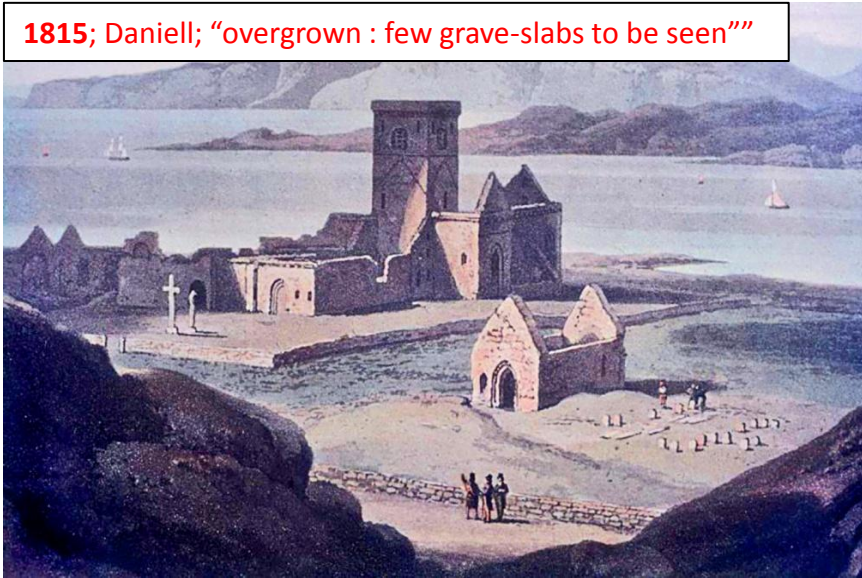
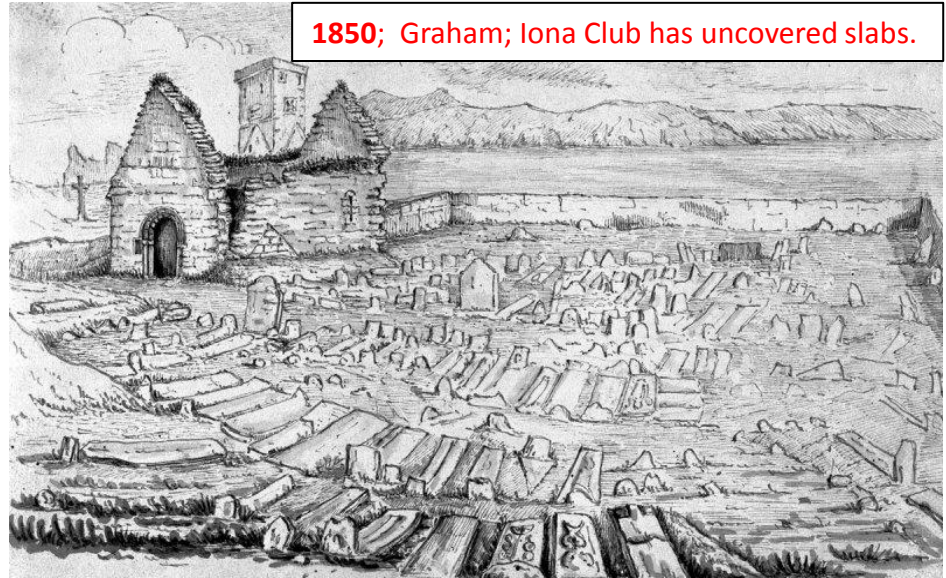


St Oran's outside cemetery, Iona.

Slabs of Clan Chiefs, "*the best men of the Isles*" (re-arranged, fenced by the Iona Club, 1854-59).

They include a "Tomb" for the Chiefs of each of the Clan Donald Branches. "Each of these chief families of the Isles had its claim to a tomb in the Reilig Odhrain, if not by right of descent from the house of Somerled then by right of marriage into Clan Donald."
